CALL FOR APPLICATION ERASMUS+ STAFF MOBILITY FOR TEACHING

WHAT

What is supported?

Part of travel and subsistence expenses is supported if the teaching staff gives a guest lecture for at least 8 hours per week at a partner university within the EU. If the mobility period is less than 5 days, the duration of the lecture is calculated on a pro rata basis. The mobility for teaching can be combined with a mobility for training.

WHEN

For which period?

Effective immediately for mobility duration of 2 to 5 days (excluding travel days). The grant cannot be awarded retroactively.

WHO

Who can apply for the grant?

PMU teaching staff and teaching staff from the SALK provided that they carry out the mobility in the semester in which they teach and their name appears in the course catalog (or similar document).

WHERE

Where can the mobility take place?

In partner universities in the 26 EU member states including their overseas countries and territories, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, the Republic of Northern Macedonia, Serbia and Turkey. Since the PMU is an Austrian university, mobility in Austria is not eligible for funding. This also applies to PMU staff in Campus Nuremberg.

HOW

How to apply for the grant?

WHY

Why is mobility important?

It will help establish PMU as an international research and teaching university in the EU and as an Erasmus+ partner; help expand the participant's own network and improve his/her/its didactic and pedagogical skills, especially in teaching in an intercultural learning environment.

Nota bene: the “travel distance” represents the distance between the place of origin and the destination, whereas the “amount” covers the contribution to the travel both to and from the destination.

The one-time Green travel top-up grant applies to the use of the following means of main transportation from Salzburg or Nuremberg to destination or venue: bus, train (applies only for 2nd class), or carpool.

Applicable for accommodation (including breakfast) and use of local public transportation in the venue.
