CALL FOR APPLICATION ERASMUS+ STUDENT MOBILITY FOR INTERSHIPS

WHAT

What is supported?

Erasmus+ supports internships (compulsory, elective, research or industrial internship) with a duration of two full months up to a total of twelve months per study cycle (Bachelor, Master, PhD). Students can do several internships as long as the total duration does not exceed one year.

WHEN

For which period?

Effective immediately. The grant cannot be awarded retroactively.

WHO

Who can apply for the grant?

All active PMU students in the Bachelor, Master and PhD programs. Attention: mobility in Austria, in home country or country of residence during studies cannot be funded.

WHERE

Where can the mobility take place?

In the industry (e.g., companies, organizations, research institutions) or at a partner university in the 26 EU member states including their overseas countries and territories, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, the Republic of Northern Macedonia, Serbia, and Turkey. Since the PMU is an Austrian university, mobility in Austria is not eligible for funding. This also applies to students in Campus Nuremberg.
