CALL FOR APPLICATION **ERASMUS+ STUDENT MOBILITY FOR INTERNSHIPS**

WHAT is supported?

- Internships (compulsory or elective, research or industrial)
 - Minimum duration of two full months up to a maximum of twelve months per study cycle (Bachelor, Master, PhD).
 - Students can do several internships as long as the total duration does not exceed 12 months per study cycle.
 - Mobility to one host institution for the minimum duration of 2 full month (without interruption).
 - A minimum of 3 ECTS per month must be achieved.
- Internships for recent graduates:
 - eligible are recent graduates who have received the acceptance for an internship before their graduation.
 - Grant application must be submitted at least 3 months prior to graduation.
 - Participants cannot be enrolled in any study program before and during the mobility at PMU or other higher education institutions.
 - Internship must have a minimum duration of two full months (without interruption) up to a maximum of twelve months, and must be completed within the first twelve month after graduation.
- All mobilities funded through Erasmus+ will count towards the 12-month time quota per study cycle.

WHEN?

- Application is on a rolling-basis.
- Complete documents must be submitted to the International Office at least 3 months prior to the start of the mobility.
- The grant cannot be awarded retroactively.

WHO can apply for the grant?

- All active PMU students in the Bachelor, Master and PhD programs.
- Mobility in Austria, in home country or country of residence of the participants during studies cannot be funded.

WHERE can the mobility take place?

- In the industry (e.g., companies, organizations, research institutions) or at a partner university in the 26 EU member states including their overseas countries and territories, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, the Republic of Northern Macedonia, Serbia, and Turkey.
- Since the PMU is an Austrian university, mobility in Austria is not eligible for funding. This also applies to students in Campus Nuremberg.
- Mobility to one host institution

WHY is mobility important?

An internship abroad supports, among other things, the acquisition of social, professional and methodological skills, as well as the development of global citizenship, building international network and broadening horizons.

Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Republic of Northern Macedonia, Turkey, Serbia	540 EUR

Top-ups (if applicable):

- Top up for Green Travel: one-time grant amount of 50 EUR for eco-friendly travel with:
 - Train (2nd class ticket)
 - Bus
 - Carpooling (if fellow passengers travel to the same institution)
- Top up for students with fewer opportunities: grant amount of 250 EUR per month for participants who:
 - have physical disabilities or impairments
 - have chronic illness, if this results in increased financial expenses in the destination or receiving country
 - must take their children with them during the mobility.

Inclusion support (if necessary):

- Additional financial support for those who receive the top-up for students with fewer opportunities
- To cover additional costs which arise during their mobility and cannot be covered by the top up for students with fewer opportunities
- Based on the real costs incurred during the mobility
- Participants must apply separately for inclusion support prior to the mobility to the Austrian National Agency through the PMU International Office.
