Instructions for completing the Erasmus+ Grant Agreement document

- Read the Grant Agreement carefully and thoroughly.
- Complete your personal information on page 1, including your bank account information.
- Under Article 2.2, indicate the start and end dates of your physical mobility period. The start date of the mobility period shall be the first day that you need to be physically present at the receiving organization, and the end date shall be the last day you need to be physically present at the receiving organization. If you are participating in a language course provided on-site by another organization than your receiving organization, the start of your physical mobility period is the first day of that language course.
- Under Article 5.2, provide the details of your insurance policy. Please note that students are responsible for procuring the appropriate/required insurance policy.
- Under Article 6.2, indicate your proficiency level in the working language of your receiving organization.
- After Article 9, affix your signature, as well as the place and date of signing the Grant Agreement.
- Submit your completed and signed Learning Agreement for Traineeship as an attachment to your Grant Agreement.

ARTICLE 1 – SUBJECT MATTER OF THE AGREEMENT		
1.1 The organisation shall provide support to the participant for undertaking a		
mobility activity for traineeships under the Erasmus+ Programme.		
1.2 The participant accepts the support specified in article 3 and undertakes to carry out the mobility activity for [studies/ traineeships/ studies and traineeship] as described in Annex		
I.		
.3. Amendments to the agreement shall be requested and agreed by both parties through a		
formal notification by letter or by electronic message.		
ARTICLE 2 – ENTRY INTO FORCE AND DURATION OF MOBILITY		
2.1 The agreement shall enter into force on the date when the last of the two parties signs.		
The physical mobility period shall start on at the earliest and end on at the		
latest. The start date of the mobility period shall be the first day that the participant needs		
to be physically present at the receiving organisation and the end date shall be the last day the participant needs to be physically present at the receiving organisation. [Organisation		
to select for participants attending a language course provided by another organisation		
than the receiving organisation as a relevant part of the mobility period abroad: The start		
date of the mobility period shall be the first day of language course attendance outside		
the receiving organisation]. If applicable, travel days shall be added to the		

duration of the mobility period and included in the calculation of the individual support.

- The participant shall receive a financial support from Erasmus+ EU funds for 2.3 months and days. For long-term mobility: The total duration of the physical mobility period shall not 2.4 exceed 12 months, including any zero grant period. 2.5 The participant may submit a request concerning the extension of the mobility period within the limit set out in article 2.4. If the organisation agrees to extend the duration of the mobility period, the agreement shall be amended accordingly. 2.6 The Transcript of Records or Traineeship Certificate (or statement attached to these documents) shall provide the confirmed start and end dates of duration of the mobility period. ARTICLE 3 - FINANCIAL SUPPORT The financial support is calculated following the funding rules indicated in the Erasmus+ Programme Guide. 3.2 The participant shall receive financial support from Erasmus+ EU funds for _____ of physical mobility.

- 3.5 The financial support may not be used to cover similar costs already funded by EU funds.
- 3.6 Notwithstanding article 3.5, the grant is compatible with any other source of funding including revenue that the participant could receive working beyond its studies/traineeship as long as they carry out the activities foreseen in Annex I.

ARTICLE 4 – PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

- 4.1 Within 30 calendar days following the signature of the agreement by both parties or upon receipt of confirmation of arrival, and no later than the start date of the mobility period, a pre-financing payment shall be made to the participant representing 80% of the amount specified in Article 3. In case the participant did not provide the supporting documents in time, according to the sending organisation's timeline, a later payment of the pre-financing can be exceptionally accepted, based on justified reasons.
- 4.2 If the payment under article 4.1 is lower than 100% of the financial support, the submission of the participant final report via the online EUSurvey tool shall be considered as the participant's request for payment of the balance of the financial support. The organisation shall have 45 calendar days to make the balance payment or to issue a recovery order in case a reimbursement is due.

ARTICLE 5 – INSURANCE

- 5.1 The organisation shall make sure that the participant has adequate insurance coverage either by providing itself the insurance, or by making an agreement with the receiving organisation for the latter to provide the insurance, or by providing the participant with the relevant information and support to take an insurance on their own.
- 5.2 Insurance coverage shall include at minimum a health insurance, a liability insurance and an accident insurance.

5.3 The responsible party for taking the insurance coverage is the participant.

ARTICLE 6 – ONLINE LINGUAGE SUPPORT [Only applicable for mobilities for which the main language of instruction or work is available in the Online Linguistic Support (OLS) tool), with the exception of native speakers]

- 6.1. The participant must carry out the OLS language assessment in the language of mobility (if available) before the mobility period. The completion of the online assessment before departure is a pre-requisite for the mobility, except in duly justified cases.
- Optional-only if not included in the Learning Agreement: The level of language competence in that the student already has or agrees to acquire by the start of the mobility period is: A1 \square A2 \square B1 \square B2 \square C1 \square C2 \square
- 6.3 Only applicable to participants following an OLS language course: The participant will follow the OLS language course of their choice, starting as soon as they receive access and making the most out of the service. The participant will immediately inform the organisation if he/she is unable to carry out the course, before accessing it.

ARTICLE 7 – FINAL PARTICIPANT REPORT (EU SURVEY)

- 7.1. The participant shall complete and submit the participant report (via the online EU Survey tool) after the mobility abroad within 30 calendar days upon receipt of the invitation to complete it. Participants who fail to complete and submit the online final report may be required by their organisation to partially or fully reimburse the financial support received.
- 7.2 A complementary online survey may be sent to the participant allowing for full reporting on recognition issues.

ARTICLE 8 – DATA PROTECTION

8.1. The sending organisation shall provide the participants with the relevant privacy statement for the processing of their personal data before these are encoded in the electronic systems for managing the Erasmus+ mobilities. https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/erasmus-and-data-protection/privacy-statement-mobility-tool

ARTICLE 9 – LAW APPLICABLE AND COMPETENT COURT

- 9.1 The Agreement is governed by Austrian law.
- 9.2 The competent court determined in accordance with the applicable national law shall have sole jurisdiction to hear any dispute between the organisation and the participant concerning the interpretation, application or validity of this Agreement, if such dispute cannot be settled amicably.

Annex II

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Article 1: Liability

Each party of this agreement shall exonerate the other from any civil liability for damages suffered by them or their staff as a result of performance of this agreement, provided such damages are not the result of serious and deliberate misconduct on the part of the other party or his staff.

The National Agency of Austria, the European Commission or their staff shall not be held liable in the event of a claim under the agreement relating to any damage caused during the execution of the mobility period. Consequently, the National Agency of Austria or the European Commission shall not entertain any request for indemnity of reimbursement accompanying such claim.

Article 2: Termination of the agreement

In the event of failure by the participant to perform any of the obligations arising from the agreement, and regardless of the consequences provided for under the applicable law, the organisation is legally entitled to terminate or cancel the agreement without any further legal formality where no action is taken by the participant within one month of receiving notification by registered letter.

If the participant terminates the agreement before its agreement ends or if they fail to follow the agreement in accordance with the rules, they shall have to refund the amount of the grant already paid.

In case of termination by the participant due to "force majeure", i.e. an unforeseeable exceptional situation or event beyond the participant's control and not attributable to error or negligence on their part, the participant shall be entitled to receive at least the amount of the grant corresponding to the actual duration of the mobility period. Any remaining funds shall have to be refunded, except if agreed differently with the sending organisation.

Article 3: Data Protection

All personal data contained in the agreement shall be processed in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the EU institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data. Such data shall be processed solely in connection with the implementation and follow-up of the agreement by the sending organisation, the National Agency and the European Commission, without prejudice to the possibility of passing the data to the bodies responsible for inspection and audit in accordance with EU legislation1 (Court of Auditors or European Antifraud Office (OLAF)).

The participant may, on written request, gain access to their personal data and correct any information that is inaccurate or incomplete. They should address any questions regarding the processing of their personal data to the sending organisation and/or the National Agency. The participant may lodge a complaint against the processing of their personal data to the European Data Protection Supervisor with regard to the use of the data by the European Commission.

Article 4: Checks and Audits

The parties of the agreement undertake to provide any detailed information requested by the European Commission, the National Agency of Austria or by any other outside body authorised by the European Commission or the National Agency of Austria to check that the mobility period and the provisions of the agreement are being properly implemented.
